 - iii. Possible survey to send out and see if there are any needs or gaps that need to be filled in each school community.
 - iv. Provide learning resources that we can share with the BHS community
 - v. Thinking on ideas of how we can utilize our parent volunteers
 - vi. Help connect youth with tutors. Keep a curated list.
 - vii. Peter Bang-Knudsen update:
 1. Recap on last quarter of 2019-2020 school year
 2. Spent the summer making sure everything across the board to be similar: Zoom, Google Classrooms, etc... Training for all teachers.
 3. Online will be at least the first 9 weeks of school. Stager one grade at a time when we begin to bring back in-person.
 4. Consideration for coming back is not just students, but staff that comes from all over the county and Seattle.
 5. Consistent messaging.
 6. 10% of kids choose to be all online for the 2020-2021 school year.
 7. Teachers will teach classes from their classrooms instead of home.
