Odyssey PTO – Budget proposal for 2023-24 school year – for web site posting

Tuesday, May 16, 2023

The following budget is presented by Ken and Timi Cecka, Treasurers for the 2022-2023 school year.

Governance

The budget has been reviewed, discussed and amended by a budget review committee (including current and future PTO Officers and fundraising committee) on April 30th 2022, and will be presented at a meeting of the full parents' community on May 18th. This version of the budget proposal is to be posted on the web site for 30 days before a vote around June 16th.

Notes about the budget

As the school year comes to a close, it is time to review and approve a new budget for 2023-24. Here a few key numbers to consider:

2022-23 total budget: \$81K2022-23 fundraising: \$58K

Projected bank balance to carry over into 2023-24 school year: \$29K

We started the 2022-23 school year with a significantly larger bank balance; that surplus, in combination with our fundraising efforts leave us in a healthy financial position to start the 2023-24 school year. Thankyou Odyssey families and fundraising team for getting us over the finish line!

As we are not expecting a significant surplus for this school year (our goal is to carry \$20K-\$30K over every year in order to pay for our fall and winter expenses, which include Outdoor Ed subsidies for 7/8's), we are proposing a budget for the 2023-24 school year which matches an achievable fundraising goal for the year. The attached budget proposes a total of \$73K for the 2023-24 school year, with the primary reduction coming from a reduced Outdoor Ed subsidy.

Here's a summary of the 2023/24 costs per student:

• Fundraising goal per student: \$330

• Outdoor Ed fee per student:

Kindergarten: \$75 (one day)
1-2 graders: \$150 (two days)
3-8 graders: \$225 (three days)

Camp Parsons fee per person: ~\$40 (TBD)

Note that the fundraising component is a voluntary/community effort, while the fees are paid directly by families with their event registration/participation. We would like to emphasize that there are scholarship funds available from multiple sources to cover fees for anyone (just let Michelle know when registering).
